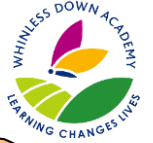


Early Years Term 2



This term your child will be learning to...



Communication, Language and Literacy

Make meaningful marks in their play, write their name and begin to write simple words. Understand rhyme and alliteration, hear and say some letter sounds and retell simple stories including Whatever Next!

Understanding the world

Begin to understand why things happen and how things work. Talk about a person from the past e.g. Guy Fawkes. Know and talk about a range of different festivals, such as Bonfire Night and Christmas and talk about how and why we are special.

How can I make it?

Maths

Develop accurate 1-to-1 correspondence when counting objects. Begin to link numerals to their values. Begin to know number facts of 3 and 4. Use numbers and shapes in mark making and use language to describe pattern, position and shape.

Expressive Art and Design

Use a variety of materials to make new things and learn new skills whilst constructing and making. Make 3D models and pictures of fireworks. Mix colours and create objects linked to celebrations, such as cards and decorations.
