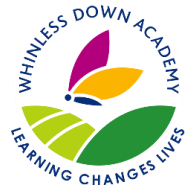










Early Years Home Learning TERM 2 - How can I make it?

Maybe you could draw your favourite part of the story in your book.</p> 	<p>Can you use 2D shapes to make a picture? You could make a house, a rocket, a flower or anything you choose. See if you can include a circle, rectangle, square and triangle.</p> 
<p>Making and crafting is so much fun. Can you make your own Christmas decoration to hang on your Christmas tree? What materials will you use?</p> 	<p>Find some old magazines or packaging and see if you can cut out the letters to spell your name and stick it in your book.</p> 	<p>Can you go on a walk to the woods or the beach? See what treasures you can find. Can you find any shells? A nut? A round leaf? Can you count how many things you find?</p>
