See if you can make it the right colour and size.</p>	<p>We have been reading Whatever Next by Jill Murphy. In the story, baby bear flies to the moon and has a picnic. Can you make your own picnic lunch? You could make a sandwich or prepare a salad.</p>	<p>Have a game of Ispy with somebody at home. You could use objects in your home or the sheet below to help you.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">"Ispy with my little eye, something beginning with tttt" (table)</p>
<p>We have been learning about numbers 0-5. Can you use household objects to make different values to 5? You could have 2 cars, 4 raisins or 5 lego blocks. Can you compare the different amounts?</p>	<p>Listen to the story Whatever Next here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6c5cb0uOrPM After listening to it, can you retell the story with someone at home? You could use some props that you have at home such as wellies, a cardboard box or a colander.</p>	<p>At school we have been enjoying a game of Sound Talk with Metal Mike. Metal Mike is a robot and likes to say all of the sounds in each word e.g. c-a-t. Take turns with your grown up to sound talk and guess some simple words, which you can find around your house, for example, pen, pin, hat etc.</p> 
<p>We enjoy doing jigsaws at school. Do you have a jigsaw puzzle at home that you could complete with someone at home? If not, you could make your own using the template below or you could explore the Cbeebies puzzles here: https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/curations/cbeebies-jigsaw-puzzles</p>	<p>Can you sing along to some nursery rhymes? For example, Humpty Dumpty, Twinkle Twinkle Little Star or Hey Diddle Diddle. Can you spot the words that rhyme?</p>	<p>In phonics, we have been tuning in to sounds and learning that some sounds are loud, some are quiet, some are long and some are short. Can you create some different sounds at home? You could make some popping popcorn or stamp your feet.</p>

<p>Can you listen to some music that you enjoy? Draw a picture or do some dance moves to represent how it makes you feel.</p>	<p>Guy Fawkes is a person from the past that we will be learning about this term. Can you research some facts about him to share with your friends?</p>	<p>We have been learning how to use scissors carefully and accurately for cutting. Can you cut along the lines below carefully? You could also practice cutting some snips of paper, some herbs or some ribbon.</p>
<p>This term there are lots of exciting celebrations for us to enjoy such as Halloween, Bonfire Night and Christmas! Can you make your own picture to celebrate one of these things? You could make a print or draw a picture.</p>	<p>We live on planet Earth but there are many other things in our solar system such as stars, the moon and other planets. As it gets dark, go out and see if you can spot the moon. Watch each day to see what changes occur.</p>	<p>Pretend you are walking on the moon! Can you explore some different movements that you might make, for example, hopping over the rocks, floating through the atmosphere, crawling under the rocket</p>
<p>You see fireworks on bonfire night. Can you make your own firework display? You could use paints, glitter, tissue paper etc.</p> 	<p>We are exploring ways of how we can we make things. Think of something you would like to make. Ask a grown up to help you use the internet to research more about your item. What things will you need to make it?</p>	<p>Design your own Colour Monster. How are they feeling today? Happy? Sad? Angry? Calm? What could you do to change their mood?</p>

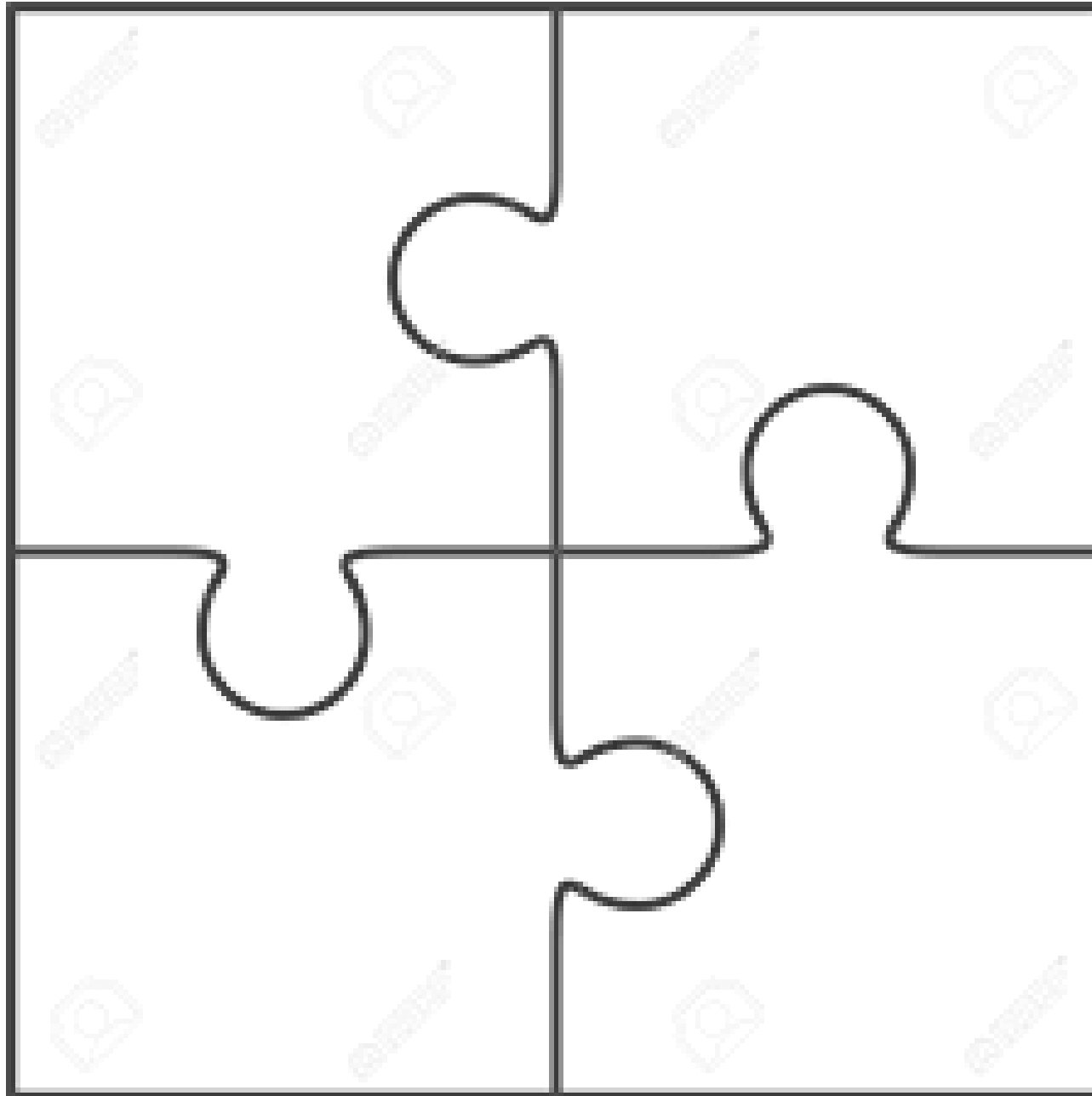

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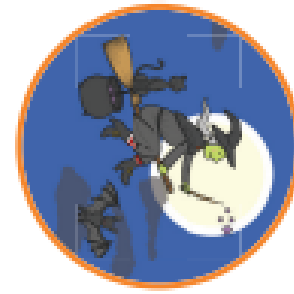
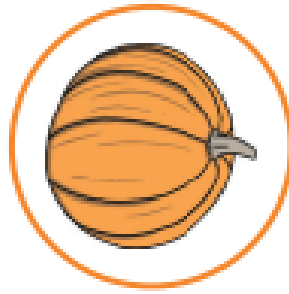
