Reading Challenge	Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s	Spelling	Phonics
<p><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Read daily to earn points towards the reading pond.</p> <p>When you have read your book, can you answer any questions your adults may ask you?</p> <p><u>They could ask...</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Predict what will happen on the next page. -Summarise what has happened through this text. -Define a word. <p>(Use the questioning sheet handed out last term 😊)</p>	<p><u>Counting</u></p> <p>Use a 100 square to support you.</p> <p>How many different voices can you use when counting in 2s 5s and 10s? Can you make them into a song?</p> <p>For 2s and 5s, start by going up to 20 and when you are confident add 10 more each time.</p> <p>For the 10s, go all the way up to 100 then can you count back to 0 again?</p> <p>100 Square Splat - can you splat the numbers as you go to support this?</p> <p>Find a song on YouTube to sing along to, in Deal Class we like Jack Hartmann!</p>	<p><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>Children will have spellings for this term.</p> <p>he, she, me, we, be, was, you, they, all, are, my, her</p> <p>Practise your termly spellings by writing them in lots of different ways. Focus on 2-5 each week. Can you use different objects around the house to make the words? Make your own word cards and decorate them.</p> <p>Hide the word cards around the house and when you find them, copy them onto a board. Use chalk or water and paint brushes to write them on the ground outside.</p> <p><u>Challenge</u> - have you remembered how to spell them while writing a sentence?</p>	<p><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Go onto the phonics Play website.</p> <p>Using the Phase 4 section play buried treasure and practise segmenting the words and blending them together. Can you make your own alien words?</p> <p>Play sentence substitution. Can you create your own silly sentences?</p>

<p>Our key book this term is 'Where the Wild Things Are' by Maurice Sendak.</p> <p>Create your own 'wild thing' and describe it using adjectives. E.g. long tail, sharp teeth.</p>  <p>Challenge - put your adjectives into a sentence.</p>	<p>Use this picture to inspire your writing.</p> <p>You can use it to describe what you can see or to write a story.</p> 	<p><u>Number bonds to 10 and 20</u></p> <p>Practise making number bonds to 10 and 20 using lots of different objects. E.g. 5 socks and 5 hats or 2 apples and 8 bananas. Remember the total will always be 10 or 20.</p> <p><u>Challenges</u></p> <p>Pick a challenge on the next page.</p> <p><u>Top marks website:</u> Play 'Hit the Button' using number bonds to 10 and 20. How accurate and how fast can you be?</p>	<p><u>Positional Language</u></p> <p>Can you make a treasure map and using positional language to direct the user to the treasure? For example: Turn left/right, over/under, in front of/behind.</p> <p>What obstacles can you put in the way? There could be a swamp of crocodiles, a volcano, even a cave with a dragon!</p>

<p><u>Autumn</u></p> <p>Go on an autumn walk with your family and gather some materials such as leaves and sticks.</p> <p>Using your materials make an autumn crown or collage.</p> <p>TOP TIP</p> <p>While you are out, get some tree rubbings or leaf rubbings to add as well!</p>	<p><u>Weather</u></p> <p>Keep a weather diary for a week (or longer). Draw a picture to show each day and describe it. What adjectives can you use to describe each day?</p> <p>How does the weather change? Can you measure the temperature?</p>	<p><u>Seasons</u></p> <p>Draw a picture of what you would wear in each season and label it.</p> <p>Challenge</p> <p>Write a sentence underneath explaining why.</p>	<p>Listen to a piece of peaceful music. Close your eyes and imagine what it is representing.</p> <p>Can you describe this to an adult? You could draw a picture of this image.</p> <p>TOP TIP</p> <p>Draw something while you're listening to this music. It could be a picture of something or just shapes.</p>
