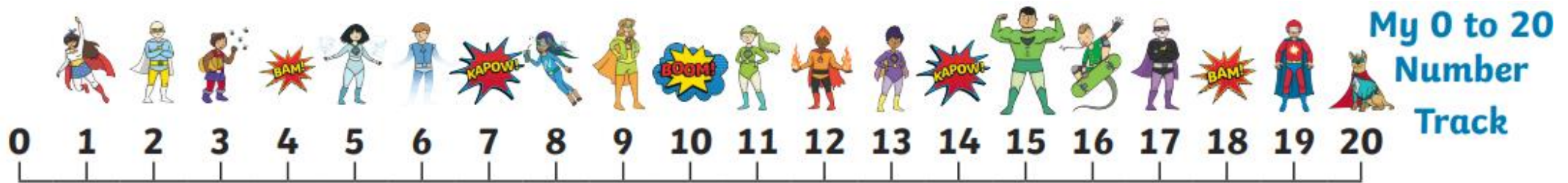

Pitta Bread Pizza

Ingredients:

- 1 pitta bread
- Tomato puree
- Grated cheese
- Toppings of your choice (maybe try peppers, ham, sweet corn or mushrooms).

Method

- 1.) Use a knife to spread the tomato puree onto the pitta bread
- 2.) Safely grate the cheese and sprinkle on to the pitta bread
