# Parent Feedback

## We responded...

Although we are unable to offer a complete wraparound care arrangement, we work hard to staff our after school clubs to support parents who require this sort of provision. We have, over the last 18 months, increased our capacity to offer more after school clubs and have plans to add a further two clubs by the summer term.

#### You said...

You were concerned that the school weren't offering enough daily exercise.

#### You said...

Home Learning: Some parents prefer weekly, others prefer termly home learning. Some commented on it being too much and some felt there was inconsistency in challenge across classes.

## We responded...

We send out termly home learning grids, which include weekly and termly challenges for children to chose from. We recognise that not all families operate in the same way and find this brings flexibility to families, allowing them to chose how much home learning they complete and when. We plan to review the Term 3 grids to monitor progression in challenge.

### We responded...

Last academic year, our PE leads introduced 'Engergise' sessions to increase daily exercise. In addition to their weekly PE session, children have 10 minutes of daily physical activity, which may include a daily mile, yoga, dance or another physical activity. Our 'Active Playground', offers sporting activities such as basketball, football, trike /bikes, skipping, parachuting etc.
