In English our focus text is going to be 'The Snail and the Whale'. We will be able to retell this story in multiple different ways and explore the characters and settings. At the end of this story we are going to be able to recreate 'The Snail and the Whale' using our own ideas and imaginations. For non-fiction we will be able to explore reading non-fiction texts, looking at the features and practising finding information independently. We can then create our own non-fiction text on your chosen area!



Science

In science, we will be exploring David Attenborough and we will be able to classify a variety of different animals by looking at their features. We will also be able to use the vocabulary of herbivore, omnivore, and carnivore based on our knowledge of what the animals diet is.

We will be using the laptops to explore how to create digital art and pictures. Once we have become professionals at this we will be creating and adding sound to the digital art that we have made.

To be able to do this we will be remembering how to save and re-load our work on Purple Mash.

In PSHE...

We will be exploring the concept of money. What is it? What do we do with it? Also, how can we keep our money safe? We will be able to have a 'class shop' to practise whether we would prefer to spend money or save it.
