2024 SATs Update

The KS2 Y6 tests will commence on Monday 13 May and the last test will take place on Thursday 16 May.





This term in number maths, we will be learning about ratio, proportion and algebra. We will solve algebraic problems involving unequal sharing and grouping, using our knowledge of fractions and multiples and learn to express missing number problems algebraically.

In topic maths, we will learn to interpret and construct pie charts and line graphs and solve real-life problems involving charts.







This term in English, we are reading, 'Letters from The Lighthouse' by Emma Carroll. We will create evacuee characters for ourselves and we'll be writing diary entries as those characters and writing letters about their experiences during WW2.

Non-fiction: Newspaper reports, linked to WW2 and non-chronological reports on Operation Dynamo. Please make sure that you are reading daily.

World War 2

This topic has a focus on our children being able to empathise with those children who lived through WW2. They will be interpreting historical information in the form of writing, audio and images and will be able to explain the causes of WW2; the countries involved in the war; significant battles of WW2 and will explore how Dover and its inhabitants were affected by WW2.

In Art/DT...

Continuing our WW2 topic, children will learn about designers in history and study the designs of the Morrison Shelter and the Anderson Shelter. They will then design and make their own shelter. In art, children will explore the use of different mediums to produce artwork that portrays the Blitz.

In Music...

Year 6 will be: reading music; understanding how the note length differs based on the symbol used; use accompaniments to add texture to a melody.

In RF

We will be exploring the main question: what matters most to Christians and Humanists?
We will ask how should we care for others and the world, and why does it matter? Also, what can we learn from religions about deciding right and wrong?

In PSHE...

Year 6 will explore the question: how can the media influence people? They'll learn how information is ranked, selected and targeted to meet the interests of individuals and groups, and can be used to influence them. They'll understand how to respond, and report, information viewed online which is upsetting.

In Computing...

The children will be learning to use Google Sketchup to make 3D models.



In MFL...

We will build upon our conversational skills and talk about activities that children might do at the weekend.
