Learning to Dream, Learning to Believe, Able to Succeed!

Thank you for taking part in our March parent survey!

As well as asking for feedback about previous initiatives, we also asked parents about our home learning approach.

Here are the results from Section 2 of our survey:

85% of parents said their child enjoys activities on the home learning grids.

52% felt that there was just the right amount of home learning. 38% felt there was too much and 11% felt too little.

There were mixed ideas given in the free-text box, but some comments that were made more than once included: - having more tasks children could do independently - having more Maths and English tasks

We are planning to hold a parent drop in session to give parents opportunity to discuss home learning further with the leadership team - dates to follow soon!
