Expressive Arts & Design

or on food packaging at home. Can you find any of the digraphs and trigraphs that we have learnt?

Maybe you could photograph them, circle them or cut them out and stick them in your books.



Maths & Understanding the World

Have a look in the kitchen for 6 different objects. Make sure you have an adult to help you. Which one is the heaviest? Which one is the lightest? Can you put them in order from lightest to heaviest?



Look at some of the food in your cupboards and fridge. Where in the world do they come from? Write a list in your book.



The beanstalk in Jack and The Beanstalk grew VERY tall. Can you find something in your house that is taller than you are and something that is shorter than you are? Draw and label them in your book.



We have been learning about numbers 9 and 10. Can you count 9 and 10 objects in your house and write the numbers in your homework book.



Different people from around the world wear different types of jewellery. Can you research jewellery from around the world and then design and make your own? You could use cardboard, beads or string.



We have been learning all about lifecycles.

Can you choose an animal or plant and research their lifecycle with someone at home? Can you draw it in your book? You might choose a frog, sunflower or a ladybird.



We have been growing plants at school this term. Can you try to grow some at home? Remember to be Respectful Rhinos and look after them as they grow! You could take some photos of the changes that you see!
