maths 123

This term in maths, we will be recapping place value and addition and subtraction. We will be learning how to compare and order numbers up to 1000, recognising the place value of each digit in a three-digit number, adding and subtracting numbers with three digits using formal written methods and continuing to count backwards and forwards in increasing complexity.

In topic maths, we will be learning all about measure. We are going to be looking at measuring, comparing and adding and subtracting mass, volume and capacity.



This term in English, we are reading the brilliant book 'Stone Age Boy'. We are going to be learning how to use adverbs and prepositions in our writing to express time and cause. We are going to be looking at inverted commas, understanding how to use apostrophes for omission and also how to identify 1st and 3rd person pronouns and apply this to our writing. We are also going to be looking at information texts and will be focusing on fronted adverbials and the different types of structures for writing.

Please make sure that you are reading daily.



French

In French, we are going to be learning all about food.

In Music...

Year 3 are going to be learning how to develop their skills in playing tuned instruments and reading notation.

In Computing...

Children are going to be learning how to create an animation using the programme 'Scratch'. They will then be learning how to programme a digital game.

Once they have done this, they will be given the opportunity to play each other's games. They are also going to be recapping what an algorithm is.

In PSHE...

Children are going to be looking at the question 'Why should we eat well and look after our teeth?'. We will be looking at how to keep our bodies and teeth healthy.

We will also be looking at how sugary drinks can have an impact on our teeth if we do not brush our teeth properly.
