



Curriculum Overview :

In our creative curriculum lessons this term, we will study Greek life and their achievements. We will also be looking at their influence on the Western World and will compare the physical geography of Greece with the United Kingdom. During DT, we will be using ingredients inspired by Ancient Greece to make and evaluate a savoury dish, commenting on its appearance, taste, texture and smell. Later in the term, we will be learning about properties and changes of materials. This will include: looking at how objects can be grouped based on their properties and deciding how mixtures might be separated.

English :

This term in English, we are reading, 'Greek Myths' by Geraldine McCaughrean, and our writing will mainly be linked to a variety of Greek myths in this book. The children will showcase their writing skills, including creating descriptions of mythical creatures, newspaper reports and writing their own Greek myth. During reading, we will also be making inferences about some of the characters in the Greek myths.

Maths :

In Maths this term we will be learning about fractions, multiplication and division. We will start by looking at how to add and subtract mixed numbers to one another. Then, we will be looking at how to multiply 4-digit numbers by 1 and 2-digit numbers. After this, we will consider how we can times 2, 3 and 4-digit numbers by a 2-digit number. When we have learnt this, we will study the formal methods for division.
