

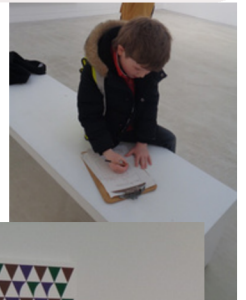
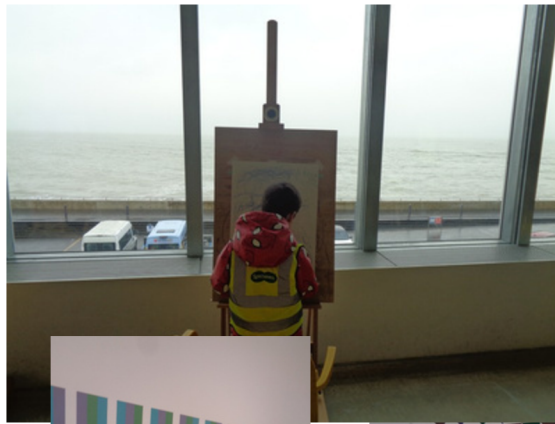

Children saw artwork by Turner and other artists and enjoyed testing out their own art skills, inspired by the pieces they saw on display.

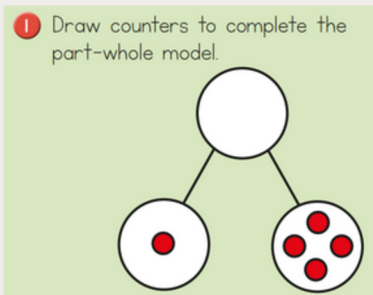
We are so proud of our children, whose behaviour was impeccable on the trip!
