Encourage children to only chat with friends they know in real life, use the platform's parental controls, and report any inappropriate messages immediately.

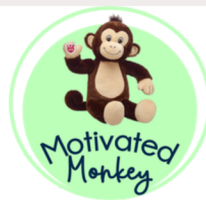
Remind them never to share personal information, including full name, address, or school details. Regular conversations about online experiences help children enjoy gaming safely and build good digital habits.

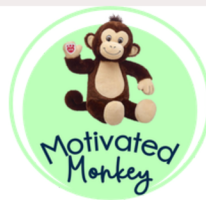
