



Curriculum Overview :

In Term 5 we will be exploring the topic of 'Precious Plants'. We will become super scientists in naming the different parts of plants and trees whilst being able to explain what plants need in order to grow. We will then become gardeners and plant our own runner beans, sunflowers, flowers and vegetables and watch them grow! We have some exciting art this term as we will be making clay pinch pots inspired by Georgia O'Keefe and observational drawings of sunflowers based on Van Gogh artwork. At the end of term, we have our DT project which we will be to create a healthy meal and we will be preparing our own salad, and making our own pizzas.

English :

In English, our Curious Quests will continue to practice and develop the skills we have been learning in the previous terms. We will be writing our own short narrative for Jack and the Beanstalk. We will then be writing our own set of instructions, using time adverbials, on how to plant a seed which we will then be following ourselves. In our writing, we will be encouraging the use of adjectives to bring to life our writing.

Maths :

For this terms math's, we will be focusing on multiplication and division, fractions and position and direction. In multiplication and division we will be learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s whilst also understanding and mastering the concepts of equal groups involving sharing and grouping. For fractions, we will be exploring halves and quarters of shapes, objects and quantities.
